### **Last Minute Details**

Please take note of the following announcements, which should cover the last minute questions most of you may be asking:

1. As stated in the Arrival Cheat Sheet, staff will be at the airport to meet you.
2. Remember to bring along a towel. You will not be provided with those. Bed linen is provided but you may bring along extra for your own convenience.
3. The voltage on appliances in Ghana is 220V. A converter will be very useful. You can purchase an adaptor if you need one.
4. Wireless Internet service is provided in the dorm and at the academic centre. There are ethernet sockets for you to plug in as well.
5. Community Service/Internship placements will be done when you arrive.
6. Accra is currently experiencing dry and relatively hot weather (harmattan) so students must apply lotion/body conditioners always to ensure that they are well moisturized throughout their stay in Accra. All are encouraged to

also apply lip gloss/balm each day to avoid cracking of lips. Soft cotton clothes will be the best to pack.

7. We recommend that students bring comfortable shoes (sneakers, etc) for field trips and program excursions such as the cape-Coast trip (visit to the Kakum National Park)
